A Message from the Executive Director of PCLC, Leslie Heimbaugh

Overcoming the barriers to self-sufficiency is one of the greatest challenges faced by an individual who is unemployed and lacking education. For more than 30 years, the Perry County Literacy Council has been moving people up from dependency to self-sufficiency with credentials that support family sustaining wages and benefits.

For at least the last ten years, PCLC has focused our efforts on transforming the fragmented system that often confronts individuals seeking employment to a more holistic and human-centered model.

When someone comes to us seeking a GED or employment, we look at the whole person. Most people we meet are motivated to work, but they face hurdles that hold them back from being a desirable job candidate. Hurdles like a lack of education, no transportation, addictions, or no access to childcare.

Rather than say "we can't help you," we've continued to grow the range of services available at our One-Stop Satellite Site so people can get the help they need and address their roadblocks. As they enter the workforce, they should have the skillsets AND the resources they need to thrive. Rather than providing fragmented services, ours is a human-centered model setting participants up for success with the tools they need to become an asset to their employer and build a better future for themselves and their families.

Support from individuals and corporations has helped make a real difference to our program participants, their families, and the community. Our ability to help Perry County residents succeed is directly connected to the local support we generate. We are hopeful that you'll join us and invest in helping motivated youth and adults on their path to self-sufficiency.

Meet John and Jeanette

High school was difficult for John Banks. Though never bullied, he couldn't stand how fellow students treated each other and felt like he simply didn't fit in. Anxious and frustrated, John spoke with his family about his concerns. This led to trying charter school and then traditional schooling once more, until the pandemic hit. John's parents recommended that he go to Perry County Literacy Council (PCLC) for classes to earn his high school equivalency diploma.

"My parents thought that I should try it out," said John. "My mom was worried because she knew that I didn't always get all my work done in school, but she knew that I cared about getting my diploma – and she had faith in me."

John loves coming to PCLC. Since entering the program last September, he has completed three of the four tests required to earn his high school equivalency diploma.



Meet Tiffany and Nicole

After a year grappling with addiction and homelessness, Kansas natives Nicole Krovas, 38, and Tiffany Ellsworth, 35, had hit rock bottom.

Shortly after Tiffany and Nicole settled in Newport, a mentor recommended that they visit PCLC. Neither of the women had a photo ID and Tiffany needed her birth certificate. Without proper ID, access to housing, employment and healthcare would be impossible. Thankfully, PCLC's social work office was ready to help.

So much has changed during the past year for Tiffany and Nicole. Both women say that they have accomplished more in the past year than they did in the last three years in Kansas, and they believe that PCLC played a big role in their success.
